- **83.8**% of students were placed within three months of graduation.
- 66.9% of students had a full-time offer
- 13.5% pursued further education or a fellowship
- <1% entered the military or public service
- 1.1% pursued entrepreneurship
- <1% had an internship
- 16.2% were still seeking


